### Abstract Guidelines:

- Capitalize all appropriate words in the title.  
Title font should be **Arial, 14 Point, Bolded**
- Except for the Title, all other aspects of the abstract should be Arial, 12 point font
- Authors should be listed with First name, Middle initial, and Last name.
- List authors' affiliations and identify the Corresponding author  
Provide email contact for corresponding author  
See below
- Limit the abstract content to 250 words or less.
- Use a structured format (i.e., **background, methods, results, conclusions**) – see below
- Do not include any tables, graphs, or other illustrations in the abstract
